RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF BLUE LAKE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 6 CALLING AN ELECTION FOR MAY 3, 2022

WHEREAS, Blue Lake Metropolitan District No. 6 (the "District") was created pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of §§ 32-1-101, et seq., C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, elections may be held pursuant to the Special District Act, §§ 32-1-801, et seq., C.R.S. (the "Act"), and the Colorado Local Government Election Code §§1-13.5, 101, et seq., C.R.S. (the "Code"), for the purpose of: (1) electing members of the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board"); (2) presenting certain ballot issues to the eligible electors of the District as required by Article X Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution; and (3) presenting certain ballot questions to the eligible electors of the District; and

WHEREAS, the terms of office of Directors Mark Bush, John Fair and Russell Watterson Sr. are due to expire after their successors are elected at the next regular election for the District, which is scheduled to be held on May 3, 2022 (the "Election"), and have taken office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF BLUE LAKE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 6 AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Election of the eligible electors of the District shall be held on May 3, 2022, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. pursuant to the Act and the Code and any other applicable laws. The Election shall be conducted as a mail ballot election in accordance with all relevant provisions of the Act and the Code. All mail ballots shall be returned to the office of the Designated Election Official (as defined below in Section 2).
- 2. Micki Mills, of Collins Cockrel & Cole, P.C., is hereby appointed as the "Designated Election Official" for the Election. The Board hereby grants all powers and authority for the proper conduct of the Election required pursuant to the Act and the Code to the Designated Election Official, including, but not limited to, appointing election judges, appointing a canvass board and cancellation, if applicable, of the Election.
- 3. If the only matter before the electors is the election of directors of the District and if, by 3:00 P.M. on the 63rd day before the Election, which date is March 1, 2022, or any time thereafter, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at the Election, including candidates timely filing affidavits of intent to be a write-in candidate, the Designated Election Official shall cancel the Election and declare the candidates elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published and posted in accordance with the Code.
- 4. In the event that legislation is passed and enacted into law that impacts or changes the methods or procedures for elections conducted by the District, the Board hereby directs its legal counsel and the Designated Election Official, without any further action taken by the Board unless otherwise required by applicable law, to take all actions necessary and appropriate to conduct the Election in compliance with any applicable laws including, but not limited to,

coordinating the Election with any political subdivision with appropriate jurisdiction over the District and adjusting any Election-related deadlines.

- 5. If any part or provision of this Resolution is adjudicated to be unenforceable or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remaining provision or provisions of this Resolution, it being the intent of the Board that the various provisions are severable.
- 6. All acts, orders and resolutions, or parts thereof, of the Board that are inconsistent or in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.
 - 7. The provisions of this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
